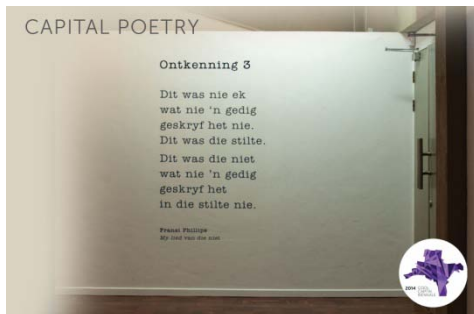

As part of the Cool Capital project the #MyCoolCapital Campaign is both a twitter campaign as well as a public artwork made by the people of Pretoria. The general idea and tag line is "mapping the capital's people". What is it? #MyCoolCapital is a digitally created physical map of the capital using only adjectives as hashtags for the different suburbs and streets. The general public will submit a hashtag (adjective) for their address. This will then be printed out on a large "map" of Pretoria on the location that they submitted. These hashtags will then slowly map out the general feel of the different suburbs and areas of the capital. For example: A user can submit #classy #Waterkloof for 23 Main Rd Waterkloof. On the artwork/map the word "classy" will be printed in the area of 23 Main Rd Waterkloof.

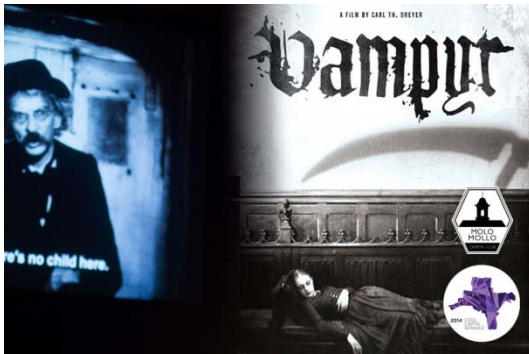

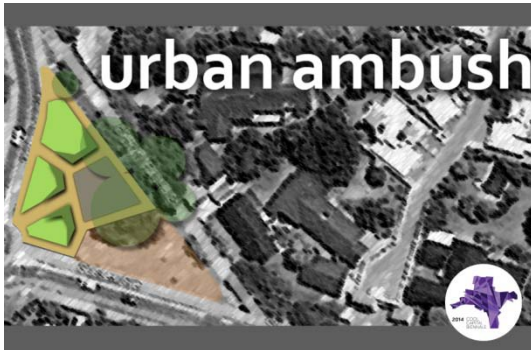

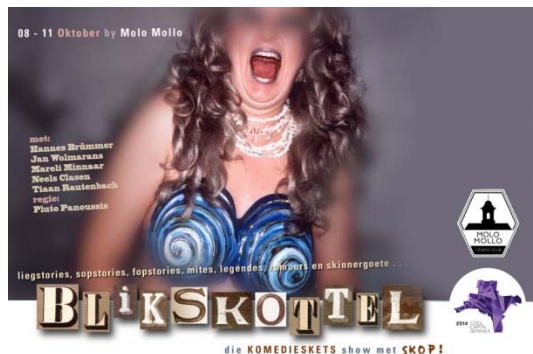
